Experience in Arbitration

In 2019, Francisca Seara Cardoso joined *Armesto & Asociados* to work in a team with the founding partner Juan Fernández-Armesto. Francisca acts as secretary and assistant to arbitral tribunals in arbitration proceedings, including international, *ad hoc* and administered arbitrations involving both commercial and investment disputes.

Most of the cases are administered by ICC, ICSID, PCA and Spanish or Latin America arbitral institutions. As to *ad hoc* arbitrations, most of them are subject to the UNCITRAL Rules.
